

The Josephine Herrick Project is a 76 year old non-profit service organization that works with a range of local and national partners, including regional, city and community-based organizations, schools, libraries, hospitals and social service agencies to provide free photography programs to vulnerable, underrepresented and marginalized populations led by professional photographers.

For our students, the camera is a transformative tool for self-expression, community exploration and confidence building. They engage with the world through photography, tell their stories, and culminate their experience in the creation of photography exhibits and books.

The Josephine Herrick Project is the proud winner of the Lucie Humanitarian Award 2017.

#### **Nassau Veteran Center**



The VSA serves veterans as an advocate for compensation, pension, education and training, vocational rehabilitation, and additional benefits for survivors, burial, and hospital care.


